BRIEF HISTORY OF CATHOLIC GRADUATES- CG (NFCS ALUMNI)

IDEATION AND BIRTH

Catholic Graduates (CG), formerly Nigeria Federation of Catholic Students-(NFCS) Alumni was birthed following the profuse family love that existed between members (especially officers) of Nigerian Federation of Catholic Students (NFCS) Provincial Executive Council-PEC from the various higher institutions within the Owerri Ecclesiastical province.

With the support of the first and second Chaplains of NFCS Owerri Ecclesiastical Province, Rev. Fr. Joseph Ejimofor and Rev. Fr. Prof. Mike Ukah, respectively, the occasion of the send-forth organised by the then Provincial Executive Council members (1998-2000) led by Bro Chigozie Onwukwe in honour of the first Provincial Executive Council-PEC members (1996-1998) of NFCS - Owerri Province led by Bro McDonald Ofurum respectively, on the 8th of August 1998, at Federal Polytechnic, Nekede, provided a launching pad to propagate the idea and desire to continue as NFCS ALUMNI as unanimously agreed by the out-going PEC and graduating NFCS members. With this solid agreement, some members of the out-going PEC worked all through the 8th August 1998, to give flesh to this idea in terms of organizational structure, membership requirements and other key issues like name, vision and purpose of the proposed NFCS Alumni. This was very critical because the inauguration of the new NFCS Alumni members and Exco was set for the next day, Sunday, 9th August 1998. Selecting the pioneer executive of the new body was the toughest conversation of the day as Bro McDonald Ofurum who had played prominent roles in the formation of NFCS Alumni declined to continue to lead after graduation. Among the graduating members present at this auspicious meeting were Bro. McDonald Chukwubuikem Ofurum, Bro Chinedu Nnaemeka Ogbuji, Bro Chimobi Nwoke, Bro Eustace Toochi Ohaji, Bro Sixtus Nwaneri, Sister Thecla Onyeanya, Bro Ikenna Affam, Bro Jude Anyanwu (Now Rev Fr. Dr. Jude Anyanwu) and few others. In the spirit of God and Catholic love, Bro Chinedu Ogbuji was selected and after much prompting accepted to lead the organization as its pioneer President. The other pioneer officers were Late Sister Chinwe

Onyenagada (Vice President), Bro. Chimobi Nwoke (General Secretary), Bro Eustace Toochi Ohaji (Assistant Secretary). Bro. McDonald Ofurum (Financial Secretary) and Sister Thecla Onyeanya (Treasurer). These officers and others in the graduating class of NFCS present at the send – forth Mass celebrated by Fr. Hilary Diachelem (Now Bishop of Bauchi Diocese) the next day, were inaugurated, commissioned and inducted with the responsibility of nurturing the growth and development of this young association. This marked the beginning of the body-CATHOLIC GRADUATES-CG (NFCS ALUMNI) Owerri Province, with the motto, LIGHT OF THE WORLD as subsequently suggested by Bro McDonald Ofurum on a later date and generally adopted by all.

GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT:

One must not fail to point out that the moment CG was born, the then Archbishop of Owerri, His Grace Most Rev. Dr. AJV Obinna and our Pioneer Chaplain, Rev Fr. Dr. Jude Ike gave us ample invaluable support to skyrocket the growth of CG. Bro. McDonald Ofurum who often interfaced between CG and the then Archbishop was equally very instrumental to the growth and development of CG. Due to the untiring efforts of Bro McDonald, the Archbishop then often jokingly referred to us as **ndi otu McDonald;** anytime we were opportune to have audience with him.

As a way of ensuring sustainability, it was agreed by members that an annual Reunion, General meeting and Dinner be held every 2nd weekend of August. The early years of CG Annual Re-union, General Meeting and Dinner was championed by Bro. McDonald C. Ofurum and Bro Eustace Toochi Ohaji with support from the then Exco led by Bro Chinedu Ogbuji. Pioneering the growth and development of CG was not an easy task as the National Youth Service Corp program and search for greener pastures scattered the pioneer members to different parts of the country. The absence or at best, paucity of effective internet enabled mobile communication did not make it any easier.

The foundation members of CG thought out the following subsisting aim and objectives as guiding principles and core values.

AIM AND OBJECTIVES: The aim and objectives of the Association are;

- i) To unite all Catholic Graduates of Owerri Ecclesiastical Province
- ii) To enrich the faith of its members through its various activities
- iii) To help its members understand more deeply the beliefs, teachings and, practices of the Catholic Church and to correct any misconceptions therefrom
- iv) To help its unemployed members secure jobs
- v) To help members live more practical Christian lives thus being the light in their environment
- vi) To build an Information Resource Centre (IRC) in the Owerri Ecclesiastical Province when the need arises.
- vii) To ensure that each chapter of NFCS forms her own Alumni (CG)
- viii) To help the alleviation of the sufferings of the less privileged people in the society.

Membership of CG was also proposed and later adopted in the constitution to be open to all Catholic Graduates subscribing to Owerri Ecclesiastical Province irrespective of age. The definition of "Graduates" includes all Catholics that have concluded their degree, diploma or certificate programmes of study in a recognized higher institution in Nigeria including but not limited to Colleges of Technology, Schools of Nursing, Colleges of Education, Polytechnics; Universities and Senior seminaries.

Over the years, CG has grown and supported its members, NFCS, the Church and the society in different aspects and will continue to do so.

His Grace, Most Rev. Dr. AJV Obinna, the then Archbishop and Metropolitan of Owerri Ecclesiastical Province further manifested his unflinching support to CG by appointing in succession the first three Chaplains of CG namely, Rev. Fr. Dr. Jude Ike, Rev. Fr. Ignatius Nze, and Rev Fr. Dr. Stephen Egwim respectively. Rev. Fr. Dr. Kingsley Ekeocha is the current CG Provincial Chaplain. The first grand patron of CG was Justice Chukwudifu Oputa (RIP).

In 2008, CG celebrated its 10 years of existence. This celebration was very symbolic as it marked a peaceful transition from the pioneer executive led by Bro Chinedu Ogbuji to a new executive led by Bro Henry Ogu as president. In the past 25 years, CG has held its Annual Reunion, General Meeting and Dinner which has also helped to strengthen relationships, partnerships and support to its members, NFCS, the Church and society.



Moreso, CG has fully established its presence across some other Dioceses including Aba, Umuahia and Enugu. Bro. Charles Chigozie Onwukwe and Sister Nkiru Ogbonna (Nee Nnadozie) were instrumental to the establishment of CG Aba Diocese with other members like Bro Shiwobi Obinna, Bro Ikenna Okoroafor, Bro Peter Ekenachi etc who played prominent roles at the early years of CG Aba. That same spirit of CG and the relocation circumstances to Umuahia helped Sister Nkiru Ogbonna (Nee Nnadozie) and Brother Alloy Adibe to form CG Umuahia with others. Attempts to establish CG in Okigwe, Ahiara and Orlu dioceses did not yield commensurate fruits but nevertheless we shall continue to push to extend the frontiers of CG.

ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS

The major activities of CG over the years have reflected its objectives. These activities are categorised under provincial and diocesan/chapter level activities. At the provincial level, the pilot activity is the Annual Reunion/General Meeting/Dinner that holds every second weekend in August. Since inception, CG has only missed to hold this epoch activity in the year 2020(due to Covid 19 Pandemic) and 2022.

Other activities at the provincial level include the first Saturday of the year Stakeholders meeting, executive committee meetings etc. At the diocesan/chapter level, there are usually monthly general meetings, special business meetings, valentine luncheon and easter retreats etc. Other activities may be scheduled as events demanded.

On the part of projects, CG has not faired badly especially in recent times. Even though the Information Resource Center-IRC project was earmarked from inception, it has not really been easy to actualise due to financial and time constraints. This is why this Silver Jubilee celebration is targeted at raising funds to fully embark on the INFOTECH RESOURCE AND ENTERPRENEUSHIP CENTER-IRC project. This notwithstanding, CG as a body was able to register a cooperative society with the Registrar of Cooperatives in Owerri Municipal named-Ihe Nke Uwa (Owerri Municipal) Multi-Purpose Cooperative Society. The membership of this Cooperative Society was instrumental in achieving a major milestone in terms of project by establishing the CG



Land/Housing Estate Project which acquired parcels of land from some kindreds in Oforola Community to grant CG and non-CG members cheap access to landed properties for housing and commercial purposes. Details of this project are contained in the Land Committee report.

ADMINISTRATION AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF CG

The association being a Church body made up of professionals in different fields and situated in the Catholic church recognises the supremacy of the mother Church. Borrowing from this, the Archbishop of Owerri Archdiocese appoints a Provincial Chaplain with the authority to provide both spiritual and administrative leadership and control. This notwithstanding, most chaplains in the past had chosen to allow individual members of CG exercise their democratic franchise in choosing their leaders over the years and, this has worked very well for the association. The highest decision-making body of CG is the General Meeting presided over by the Provincial president. Other arms of CG are the Board of Trustees (BOT) with pioneer Provincial President as Chairman, The Provincial Executive Committee (PEC), the Diocesan/Chapter General Meeting and the Diocesan/Chapter Executive Committee.

BRIEF HISTORY OF CATHOLIC GRADUATES ABA DIOCESE

BEGINNING:

Like the mustard seeds, the CG Aba Diocese began its operation in the year 2001 having Bro. Chigozie Onwukwe as its First Acting Diocesan Coordinator whereas Bro. Ethel Nwachukwu became its first elected Diocesan Coordinator.

THE JOURNEY:

On February 24th 2001 the first meeting was held at Abia State Polytechnic Aba. In attendance at the first meeting were:

Bro. Onwukwe Chigozie Sis. Nkeiru Ogbonna Bro. Kelechi Korie Bro. Emmanuel Osuoha Sis. Maureen Anyanwu Engr. Peter Ekenachi Bro. Ethel Nwachukwu Dr. Jude Shiweobi

and few others, this was how the journey began in Aba Diocese.

DIOCESAN CHAPLAINS:

Rev. Fr. Peter Obinna Umekwe became the first Diocesan Chaplain. He was so passionate for the establishment of CG.

He assisted CG Aba in getting the recognition and approval of the Bishop which he succeeded doing. After Fr. Obinna, Rev. Fr. Henry Uzoigwe also worked with CG Aba at the earlier stage. Followed by the immediate past Super Chaplain Rev. Fr. Kelechi Alphonsus Øhanachøm who served as our Chaplain for over 8 years.



CATHOLIC GRADUATES-CG HOUSING ESTATE (IHE-NKE-UWA HOUSING ESTATE)

The Catholic Graduates-CG Housing Estate is the brainchild of some members of the CG Cooperative- (Ihe-Nke-Uwa (Owerri Municipal) Agro Industrial Multipurpose Cooperative Society. This project which is in line with one of the objectives of CG of carrying out activities and projects that will be of much benefit to CG, the church and wider society was first muted by Sister Sylvia Anyadoh-Nwadike in 2018 and reviewed by Brothers Chinedu N. Ogbuji, Eustace Ohaji and Celestine Akubeze. Subsequently, the idea was sold to the then provincial President, Brother Uchenna Ohiagu (late) who after due discussions in the Provincial Executive Council adopted it as a provincial project with the full blessing and support of the then Chaplain, Rev. Fr. Dr. Stephen Egwim, who set up a committee with Bro. Chinedu Ogbuji as Chairman. Other members of the committee are Bro Eustace Toochi Ohaji- Secretary, Bro. Celestine Akubueze- Financial Secretary and Sister Sylvia Anyadoh-Nwadike as Project Advisor. Several conversations, visits and engagements happened between CG team and various kindred leaders mostly in Owerri North and Owerri West in a bid to see that a sizable parcel of land is acquired for the purpose at hand.

The mandate given to the committee was to:

- Initiate conversations with prospective individuals or communities to locate safe plots of land for purchase.
- To negotiate for and consolidate prices, terms and conditions for such plots of land.
- In collaboration with the CG members to market any of such acquired plots of land
- To fix reasonable prices and conditions for sale of such plots of land to CG and non-CG members
- Manage the processes of buying and selling of such plots of land and issue relevant documents to the appropriate individual in conjunction with the CG Chaplain and Exco
 - Manage any other necessary actions and conditions relating to the land to the benefit of CG.

The above mandate and other agreed roles as the engagements progressed were vigorously pursued by the committee. To ensure stronger engagements and wider consultations, more CG members were coopted into the central committee like Bro. Andy Osuagwu, Bro. Chigozie Onwukwe, Sis. Stella Nnenna Chigozie and Bro. Udechukwu Egbuhuzor.



The process of scouting for plots of land that will meet the expectations of CG as well as confirmation of the real owners of such took a long time from 2018 to 2019. This was so because CG was looking for at least, 500 plots of land that will accommodate the vision for the housing estate.

The process of a possible agreement and commencement of the housing estate business had a serious delay following the demise of the then Provincial President, Bro. Uche Ohiagu which occurred on 12 January 2019. For close to one year, every conversation about the business was put to a complete halt. To ensure that the dream doesn't die down, the new Provincial President, Bro. Regis Nwogu who was a close ally of the late President, keyed into the dream and ensured that it was actualized. The first potential agreement with the Umuakalawom kindred in Oforola, Owerri West for the proposed 400plots of land was encumbered due to the death of the President. CG decided not to continue a conversation on land matters while the architect of the business was lying in the morgue. From the time of his burial to the time declared by CG for mourning was about a year, during which time, the Umuakalawom kindred opened discussions with other possible buyers citing delay on the part of CG. It is worthy of note that before the death of the President, CG had paid two-million-naira (N2,000,000) to the community which served as commitment fee and part payment of the total agreed sum of one hundred and forty million (N140,000,000) naira for the expected 400plots. An MoU was also signed with the community which spelt out the terms and conditions for the complete payment for the land within two (2) years. This is in addition to almost one million naira expended by CG on the creation of access road to the land as well as other expenditures for each visit to the landowners. To the best of our knowledge, the said land is still not sold out completely and therefore, open for peaceful re-negotiation, other things being equal.

With the Umuakalawom business suspended, the committee was able to engage other kindreds in the same Owerri West LGA, Imo state. The first acquisition of land was eventually made in May 2019, from the Umushiama kindred. Since then, other parcels of land have been bought from Umualala kindred and some individual landowners around that territory. All the acquired parcels of land have equally been allocated to relevant subscribers.

The CG Housing Estate: (Ihe-Nke-Uwa Housing Estate) is located at CG Close, Oforola, Off Obinze-Umuokanne road (about 3 minutes' drive from FUTO junction, along Owerri-Portharcourt road, Owerri Imo State. The allocated plots are in three (3) phases within the Estate. Details of the plots



can be found in the registered survey plans and details of the financial transactions will be evident in the Statement of accounts of CG.

NEXT STEPS:

Part of the CG responsibilities in the estate is to ensure perimeter fencing and allotees compliance to the set standards of the estate. Other expected deliverables in the estate include.

- Deliver hard copy survey plans to the remaining allottees.
- Secure registration for fencing
- Build the perimeter fence round the estate.
- Ensure compliance as buyers develop their allocated plots.

- Ensure all development levies are collected from the few remaining buyers.

THE WISH

Beyond achieving the above results, it is the wish of CG to build its own CG secretariat closer to the estate. This will be another phase of the housing project which may be beside the estate or any other good location in Imo state. The secretariat could be together with the **CG INFOTECH RESOURCE AND ENTREPRENEUSHIP CENTER-IRC** being unveiled and planned now. Such projects will help to provide support to the members, the church and to the society at large.

CONCLUSION.

The committee is hopeful that all the plans of CG concerning the estate will be achieved and beyond. We thank God for leading the CG thus far and pray that more of God's Grace and protection will continue to lead us Amen. Compiled by:
